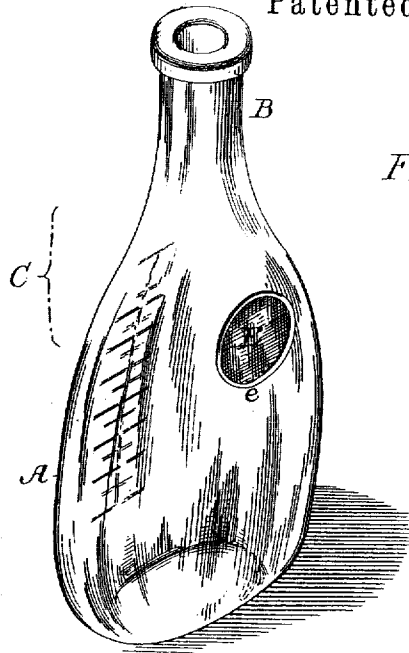

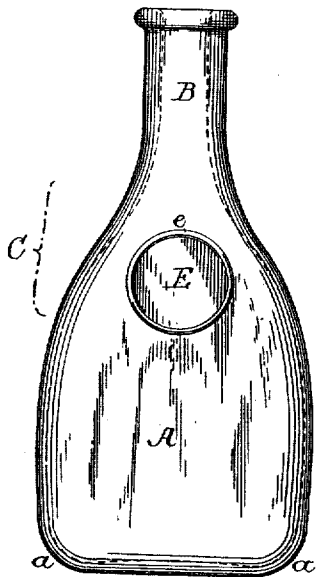

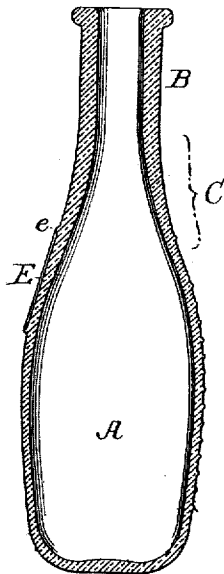
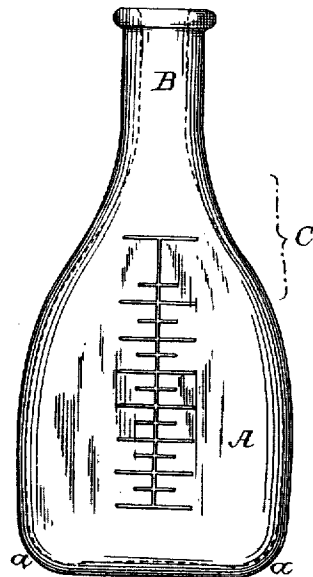

DESIGN FOR A BOTTLE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 20,527, dated February 24, 1891.

Application filed October 27, 1890. Serial No. 369,511. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, JOHN W. NICHOLSON, a citizen of the United States, and a resident of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a Design for a Nursing-Bottle, of which the following is a specification.

My design for a nursing-bottle is fully shown in the accompanying drawings, in which—

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a nursing-bottle, illustrating my design. Fig. 2 is a view of one side of the bottle. Fig. 3 is a view of the opposite side of the bottle, and Fig. 4 is a transverse sectional view of the same.

The main features of the design are the rounded body portion of the bottle, the long neck, a seal on one side of the bottle, and ribs on the opposite side of the bottle.

A is the body of the bottle, having rounded corners *a* at the base both inside and outside.

B is the neck of the bottle, joined to the body portion by a gradually-curved shoulder portion C. On one side of the bottle at the shoulder is a seal E, having a rim *e*, and on the opposite side of the body and shoulder portion are ribs.

I claim—

The design for a nursing-bottle of the shape shown and described, having on one face a seal and on the opposite face ribs, as herein shown and described.
